Technology Changes on Campus Due to Possible Reopening

Dr. Drew Maxwell began the meeting by highlighting the following changes to campus technology in preparation for a possible return to campus should the Board of Directors vote for it at the February 22nd meeting:

- Meeting with faculty members on a one-to-one basis to from February 18th through the 23rd to ensure all technology is working.
- Upgraded the internet to 2Gbps speed which is eight times faster than before.
- Evaluated all Access Points to ensure all are viable and added new Access Points outside.
- Digital Classroom Check: Drew will be meeting with 365 Managed Technology to verify that the digital classroom works during the week of February 22nd.
- New Adapter Purchases: Several types of adapters have been purchased to facilitate digital instruction.
- In the process of unboxing and updating all new devices as well as getting all backup Chromebooks unboxed and updated in anticipation of academic testing.
- Currently implementing the plan for creating charging stations across campus to allow for students to recharge devices.

Open Discussion for Looking Ahead Toward Possible Reopening

1. Can students bring their own devices?
 - Yes, it should not be a problem, but Drew will have to check with 365 that the network load works properly.
2. Will teachers be able to work from campus first to allow for some adjustment?
 - Yes, the Operations Team has already provided time for this from February 23rd through March 5th.
