higher education, Harmony Project Phoenix inspires children, empowers
schools, and transforms communities by providing vital, high-quality

HPP uses the ASA campus three times a week for programming and they are looking for a temporary part-time Site Coordinator to administratively support their students, teachers and mission while they are on our campus. The position would begin immediately and run through December 14, 2021, Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:30-8:30 p.m. and Saturdays from 8:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m. and pays \$18 per hour.
