You could become an ASA donor without doing a thing besides registering and shopping. With a few easy steps to set up your participation in these rewards programs you can make your purchases count with donations to Arizona School for the Arts:

- Visit <u>smile.amazon.com</u> and link Arizona School for the Arts to your Amazon account. Shop on AmazonSmile and the AmazonSmile Foundation will donate 0.5% of the price of eligible purchases to ASA.
- Register ASA's NPO #83762 or Arizona School for the Arts with your Fry's Rewards card online at <u>fryscommunityrewards.com</u> to earn money for ASA every time you shop for groceries.
- The new and improved Box Tops mobile app scans your store receipt, finds participating products and instantly adds Box Tops to earn cash for ASA. Visit <u>boxtops4education.com</u> and get started today.

Arizona residents have another great option available to make a donation to ASA with the Public School Tax Credit. Single taxpayers may donate up to \$200 and married taxpayers filing jointly may donate up to \$400 to the school of their choice and the taxpayer will receive a matching tax credit on that year's tax return. You do not need to have a child attending ASA to use this great benefit; it is open to all Arizona taxpayers.
