POTENTIAL SOCIAL STUDIES TEACHER Middle School: Grades 5-8 School Year 2023-2024

This faculty member works with students to build a historical consciousness and explore how our past influences our present and future. 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POTENTIAL SCIENCE TEACHER Middle School: Grades 5-8 School Year 2023-2024

The teacher will be responsible for writing their own curriculum to align with the state standards. 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POTENTIAL MATH TEACHER Middle School: Grades 5-8 School Year 2023-2024

This faculty member designs and delivers curriculum to one grade level. The students participate in a blended learning environment that combines face-to-face learning with technology and digital instruction. Learning takes place using a combination of online work, classroom work, and teacher instruction. Students will have increased control over the learning pace and activities to master the grade appropriate curriculum and beyond. Sequential course content includes 5th – 8th grade math as well as Algebra I for accelerated 8th grade students. This position requires a faculty member that can deliver two levels of instruction to a single grade of students, thus serving those students possessing accelerated math skills.

Class sizes are approximately 28 students. Academic teachers have 2.5 hours of prep time for curriculum planning, meeting, integrating, and assessing. ASA uses “Into Math” curriculum by Houghton Mifflin Harcourt. Algebra I students use the Larson Algebra I Common Core Edition. They will also be asked to differentiate their curriculum using additional resources as needed to support student growth and achievement. This teacher works closely with the Math Department and their grade level team.
