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## Frequently Asked Questions

- **What is Showcase?**
  - Since 1996, Showcase has been one of ASA's most anticipated events of the year
  - Both a fundraiser for the school and an opportunity for the community to celebrate the growth of students
  - Showcase is centered around the idea that the arts gain meaning when they're both shared and witnessed
  - A unique opportunity for students and their families to witness all of the ASA arts disciplines in one collaborative performance
- **Where is Showcase 2024**
  - Phoenix Art Museum: 1625 N Central Ave, Phoenix, AZ 85004
  - Central United Methodist Church: 1875 N Central Ave, Phoenix, AZ 85004
  - These are neighboring buildings with connected parking lots
- **My student is not in Showcase, when is their last day on campus?**
  - May 23rd
- **When is school officially over?**
  - May 31 (graduation day)
- **When are Showcase rehearsals?**
  - Specific Showcase rehearsals are on May 28th, 29th, and 30th
  - All students will have their own individualized rehearsal schedule at the beginning of May
  - All rehearsals and time frames will be written down by the student
  - Students will maintain their standard school schedule through May 23
  - There will be a Showcase Module in every arts course with all Showcase information
- **Does my student need to show up to school on the days that they don't have a rehearsal scheduled?**
  - No
  - Only students in rehearsals need to be on campus – all other students have the indicated day off
  - Do not call the attendance line if your student is not scheduled to be in rehearsal
- **If my student lost their schedule, what do I do?**
  - Have your student talk to any of their art teachers
  - They will need a new document and get all the pertinent information from each teacher
  - There will be a showcase module in Canvas in every art course with all the department information also
  - Tip: take a picture of your student's schedule(s) once they are complete - students will also be directed to take a picture

- **Where & when do I pick up my student on the ½ day rehearsals at ASA?**
  - This will be dependant on your student's rehearsal schedule
  - These schedules will be made available by May 1st
  - On days your student is scheduled to rehearse, Drop off at 7:45 and Pick Up is 11:25
  - There is no homework hour, 9th period classes, or after care scheduled on these days
- **What is the food policy at the Phoenix Art Museum and Central United Methodist Church?**
  - Students will be able to have water in their backstage rooms
  - There will be designated food areas that will be marked throughout both venues
- **Where do I drop off my student when going to the Showcase?**
  - Drop Off/Pick Up will be by the main entrance of the art museum
  - Students who drive can park in any of the available parking areas
- **Where can I park?**
  - There is available parking in the main lot at the art museum and 2 lots at the church
  - Additional parking is available at ASA, Arizona Opera (across Central), Flinn Foundation (across Central), and surrounding neighborhood
  - We will share any additional parking options through the Friday Family Email
- **Can my student bring electronics, books, and games to rehearsals?**
  - While in waiting rooms before and after rehearsals, students are allowed to use electronics, read books, and play games
  - Please make sure all materials are school appropriate
  - ASA does not assume any responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged items
- **Can my student leave the Showcase performance early?**
  - All students will have an assigned arrival time before their performance and will be able to leave after their final performance
  - Students will have the opportunity to attend as an audience member (for free) after they are done performing with guardian supervision
- **Where do I meet my student after the performance is over?**
  - Make a meeting place with your student
  - Allow for time for all students to leave the backstage areas
  - Here are some recommended landmarks:
    - The red dinosaur in front of the art museum
    - The main lobby of the art museum
    - The large rounded sculpture in Chase Gallery
    - The fountain in the Central United Methodist Church Courtyard
- **What should my student bring to rehearsals and performances?**
  - Cell Phone (so you can communicate at pick up times)
  - Music students: instrument, music, and all supplies
  - Theatre students: all items indicated by your theatre teacher
  - Ballet students: refer to the information provided by Ms. Firicano
- **What is the Concert Attire for this event?**
  - Costumes as assigned by the theatre and dance department
  - Concert Black for Music
    - Any combination of
      - Opaque black dress pants
      - Opaque black short sleeved to long sleeved dress shirts to the beltline
      - Opaque ankle length black dresses
      - Opaque ankle length black dress skirts
      - Black sweaters or jackets
      - Black dress shoes
