

Student Cell Phone Policy

High School Cell Phone Policy:

Cell phones may be used on school grounds before school, at lunch, and after school. Cell phone use is prohibited in classrooms, restrooms, and school offices unless otherwise instructed by a teacher or administrator. During instructional time, cell phones must remain out of sight and in silent mode. Headphones and earbuds may be used only at the discretion of the teacher.

Middle School Cell Phone Policy:

Cell phones, headphones, earbuds, and other telecommunications devices are prohibited from being used by students in grades 5-8 on school grounds during school hours. If a student brings a cell phone to campus, they must place it in the provided secure cabinet and pick it up at the end of the day or when a parent checks them out of school. Devices that are not properly stored and are on and/or cause a disruption during the school day will be confiscated. Confiscated devices may be picked up by the student or parent no earlier than the end of the day or upon checkout from school. Any student refusing to give the device to school staff shall be subject to disciplinary penalties in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct. Students with qualifying medical conditions may be allowed an exception to the policy at the discretion of the administration and as long as it is being used for medical purposes only. ASA will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged cell phones. Office phones are available for use as needed for essential communication with parents/quardians. Administrators shall have the discretion to determine the appropriate use of phones for students participating in extracurricular activities while on school property or while attending school-sponsored or school-related activities on or off school property.
