Dear ASA Families,

As we prepare for the upcoming school year, we are sharing important information regarding student supplies and daily expectations. These systems are designed to support organization, responsibility, and consistent academic success.

**Students are expected to arrive each day fully prepared with the necessary supplies.** A morning backpack check is an important part of building responsibility and ensuring students are ready for learning. Because students transition between multiple classrooms throughout the day and do not have access to lockers, all materials must be carried with them at all times. Supply lists have been intentionally designed to avoid excessive backpack weight while ensuring students have what they need to be successful.

**For students in grades 5 through 7, personal computers are not allowed.** Classroom computer carts are available in all lower school classrooms and will be used when instruction requires them. Students should, however, have access to a computer at home for assignments, projects, and digital work that may extend beyond the school day.

**For students in grades 8 through 12, a personal, fully charged computer is required each day.** A Chromebook or similar device is sufficient for accessing Canvas, completing assignments, and participating in classwork. Students must also bring their charger daily. A second charger kept at home is strongly recommended. The school does not provide or store spare devices or chargers; daily readiness is essential.

**Students enrolled in arts courses that require instruments must bring and transport their instruments daily.** Each student will have a designated storage space within their classroom for safe keeping before class begins. It is essential that students arrive on time in the morning to securely store their instrument and return to retrieve it prior to their scheduled arts period. This routine ensures students are prepared and ready to fully participate in instruction.

**All students will be issued a physical daily planner.** This planner is a required organizational tool and plays a key role in helping students track assignments and deadlines. Teachers will clearly communicate homework and due dates at the start of each class period, and students are expected to record all assignments, including incomplete classwork that carries over into homework. Families are encouraged to review planners regularly at home to support student accountability.

**To maintain consistency and safety across classrooms, the following items are not permitted in student backpacks: pencil sharpeners, scissors, Sharpie markers, and glue.**
