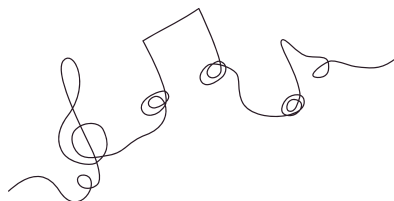


5th & 6th Grade Singing Class
